

# Usage and Backup Instructions

I created a USB stick (thumb drive) with all the website files including all the images on the website for each of you. (John, Alex, Kelly, Sue and Dawn)

There are files on the stick that are not part of the main website. Some of the files are nothing more than something I used for learning how to do some stuff, others contain some history of where our roots originated, some are family history and still others are simply musings.

We are often too busy to take advantage of opportunities but eventually we realise what we missed, this could be one of those opportunities. Perhaps one day one of you will get the urge to actually look at all the stuff and someone may actually try to improve these beginnings. There are also recipes some in Hungarian only that may be of no use to any of you but they took little room and I had them, so I included them even though I may never have tried the actual recipes. There are lots of music files obviously they are songs I valued and enjoyed for many years, including some gypsy music. I was just old enough when we left Hungary to have an interest in music even though John and Alex may not have developed that interest nor do they have the vivid memories I have of these songs. The gypsy music is **ONLY** on the stick and not anywhere on the website.

Music files run poorly from the stick web files but can be run directly from the **Musical Selections** directory/folder on the stick.

The music files are **NOT** part of the website below but everything else should be just fine!

Inserting the stick into a USB port on current generation computers will result in the stick being assigned a drive letter i.e. G: You can find the drive letter from **My Computer** It will be displayed as **JIFWEBNAME** where **NAME** is your name and a drive letter directly below i.e. **(G:)**.

Once installed you can browse the files and directories from **Windows Explorer** just like any other drive on your system.  
**(Start - Programs - Accessories - Windows Explorer)**

Though the world may change you can grow with it but currently the best way to access everything from the stick is.

Select **Start**  
Select **Run**  
type **CMD** and press **enter** (a small black screen will appear with a C: prompt)  
Once the command prompt appears type the drive letter of your stick  
i.e. **G:** (as determined above)  
type **GO** and press **enter**

One more item:  
If you click on **Mom.exe** or enter **Mom** from a command prompt you will see a slideshow of all the pictures in Mom's Album (repeats after it completes).  
Press **Esc** to end slideshow!

**Good option** highly recommended **AUTOMATIC BACKUP**

Select **Start**

Select **Run**

type **CMD** and press **enter** (a small black screen will appear with a C: prompt)

Once the command prompt appears type the drive letter of your stick from above i.e. **G:**

type **BACKWEB G**

will create a **BACKUP** of ALL the files on **C:\Web\_Stick** which can be run from your hard drive from any

Windows Explorer window by selecting any file from the above directory (**C:\Web\_Stick**) or subdirectories i.e. images or Musical Selections etc...

Optionally you may choose to copy the entire content of the stick to your computer From Windows Explorer (***NOT required if you did the AUTOMATIC BACKUP***)

Create a **New Folder** (i.e. **Web\_Stick**) on a drive of your computer **C:**

Find the USB Drive **G:** select all by pressing **Ctrl + A**

right click on any selected file (or folder) **Select copy**

Find the folder you created above (i.e. **Web\_Stick**) and select **Paste**

Now you have a copy (and a valuable backup) of all the files on the computer from the stick and you can run everything from the computer much faster than you could from the stick.

**Note:** You can have more than one explorer window active at a time which will make the process a lot easier  
(one for the computer drive and your new directory **C:\Web\_Stick** and one for the stick drive **G:** )

If you find this overwhelming you can get someone to help you do all this.  
If you are really not interested in any of this I will never know and the world will go on as usual. You may find these instructions too detailed or overwhelming but I tried to make it as simple as possible!

I did my part in sharing. You decide if any of this matters to you. **ENJOY!**

**PS:** Some things have changed with the new Versions of Windows and Internet Explorer (**IE**) Some things I changed to make it look as designed but many I may have missed or just left as it is because it was not critical to the success of the project. Some things may keep changing and may eventually become unusable.

**PPS.** I added this document to the stick in case you decide to look at the content long after this note has been misplaced or forgotten (3 version Readme .txt .pdf .docx).
